Please place your tuition in a sealed envelope with your student's name and class written on the outside of the envelope.

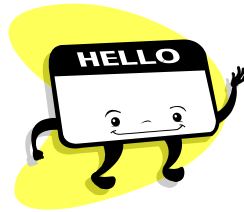

## CRBC Safety Guidelines



Every tutor and student **MUST** wear a "CRHE" badge while on campus at Council Road Baptist Church, no exceptions!!!

If you lose your badge, please make a new one for yourself with "CRHE" written on it in black marker and visible to staff members and on your person or backpack.

Students **MUST** use the door near the flagpole in the front of the classroom building (facing Council Road) to enter the building after 9:30am. You may exit from any door that has a crash bar.

**DO NOT** unlock any doors.

**DO NOT** open doors for other people to enter.

**ALL** must use the same doorway to enter the building after 9:30am.

**ALL** students found breaking these rules will be subject to being denied access to CRHE for the remainder of the year.





There are NO classes at CRHE on Wednesday, March 21 for Spring Break! Hope you all have a great week.





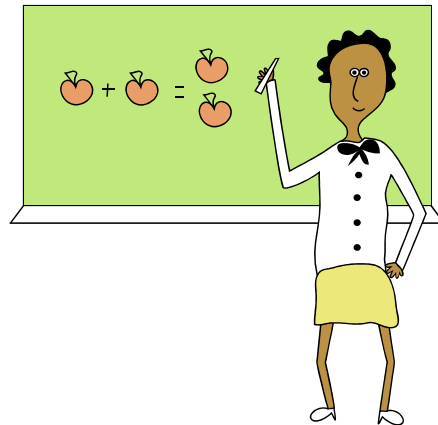
## CRHE 2012/13 Enrollment Information

An email will be sent out to notify you when all items are on the website and ready to be viewed

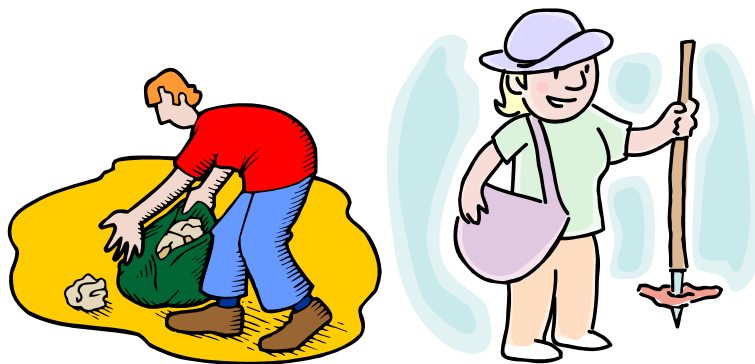




## CRBC Work Day
